Dear Mr. Broderson:

Emigration Improvement District (EID) proposes to build a water system project in Emigration Canyon. This office is preparing an environmental assessment for the project in conjunction with funding from the Federal State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Program.

Phase 1 of the project is located within the Emigration Improvement District boundaries and connects the existing Emigration Oaks water system to the existing Young Oaks Subdivision and to existing individual and small community water systems in Lower Burr Fork and Killyon Canyon. The primary purpose of this project is to provide drinking water to existing homes that do not have reliable drinking water supplies. The project locations for Phase 1 are generally in Section 27, Township 1 North, Range 1 East and Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 1 East. A map is enclosed showing the proposed water system project.
