Ken:

Thanks for an opportunity to comment on the Emigration Improvement District Water System Expansion Project.

The proposed project is in Salt Lake County, which is a non-attainment area. A non-attainment area is an area that does not meet the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). As a non-attainment area, the proposed project is subject to R307-309, Fugitive Emissions and Fugitive Dust, of the Utah Air Conservation Rules (UACR). R307-309 requires that owners or operators of a project involving the clearing or leveling of land one-quarter acre or greater in size or access haul roads submit a fugitive dust control plan to the Executive Secretary for approval. The fugitive dust control plan can be submitted to the Executive Secretary, Division of Air Quality, 150 N. 1950 West, SLC, UT, 84116.
