The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Paul Brown, acting chair. The secretary noted that a quorum was present.

UPD Report - Jake Elsasser

The UPD monthly report was distributed prior to the meeting. Officer Elsasser reported on the water main that broke along Emigration Canyon Rd yesterday morning; Emigration Place is still without water. There was a discussion of how to notify canyon residents in case of emergency. There was an update on abandoned homes. The "purple house" is in abatement. Officer Elsasser checks the abandoned homes daily.

There will be a half marathon on April 7th which is expected to affect traffic on EC Rd from 8:30 to 10:30am. Starts at golf cart bridge at mountain dell. Traffic will be open one direction. The organizers expect 400 participants and there will be 5 officers present for traffic control.

UFA Report – Michael Conn

The UFA monthly report was distributed prior to the meeting. Michael also reports there will be a CERT class in Cottonwood Heights Tues evenings March 6-Apr 3rd.

Treasurer's Report - Lincoln Nehring

The Treasurer's report was distributed prior to the meeting. Utah Neighborhood Dues and Association of Community Council dues are owed; vote was unanimous in favor of those expenditures.

Safety - Bill will be heading up this year's Firewise event and will help with CWPP. Paul Brown is tasked with CERT. Michael Conn says there is grant money available for emergency preparedness.

Gary suggests each group prepare a line item budget for presentation at the March 28th MTC meeting.
