

Minutes of Regular Meeting of Emigration Canyon Community Council
May 08, 2018

UPD Report - Officer Jake Elsasser

The UPD monthly report was distributed prior to the meeting. There were 42 calls in April and 16 reports were taken. There was one fraud case in which someone opened a loan under a resident's name. Officer Elsasser says he has boarded up a vacant home, which is in abatement. The speed trailer will be put out more this summer. Officer Elsasser asks for locations where the trailer might be needed. The owner of 3751 EC Rd is working on cleaning up the property.

UFA Report

The UFA monthly report was distributed prior to the meeting. Michael Conn was not able to attend the meeting. Paul gave Michael's report.

Treasurer's Report - Lincoln Nehring

Lincoln reported there were no expenditures since the last meeting.

Metro Township Council Update - Gary Bowen

Gary reported on the last ECMETRO meeting. He reports on some concern about the remodeling of the Camp K parking lot. He says Lewis Kogan from SLC Trails attended the last ECMETRO meeting and discussed the proposed SLC trails plan. He reports there was a discussion of posting a sign on Perkins Flat.

Firewise Planning - Bill Tobey

Bill says participants at Firewise will include UFA, Dept of Natural Resources, Wasatch-Cache National Forest, U of U Seismic Stations, Noxious Weeds, Utah Div of Environmental Quality for Radon, Jack Christensen about ham radio. The goats may be in attendance again. Volunteers needed; assignments were made to EC members. Lincoln will send to his media contacts. Kate will post notice on the website.

Trails - Dan Anderson

Dan reported on the SLC Trails plan which is in the public comment stage. ECMETRO seems to be going forward with a restroom at the corner of Emigration and Pinecrest. No trail

cleanups planned for this year. Upcoming SLCo Open Space meeting - Suzanne plans to attend.

New Business

Gary Bowen

- Public meetings for candidates - candidates from each party must be invited
- Internet - CenturyLink apparently has the capability of offering internet service to more canyon residents than previously thought.
- Mosquito abatement - Salt Lake City Mosquito Abatement district has offered to include Emigration Canyon but the cost (a tax) seems prohibitive. Gary has met with a private company that has franchise arrangements with municipalities for mosquito abatement; they suggested to publish a notice in our newsletter to request service.

Dan Anderson has received some emails about from canyon residents about animal control ordinances, short term rentals (AirBnB). Gary says some SLCo ordinances have not been adopted by the ECMETRO yet.
